Hosted on a SharePoint environment, the website serves as a collaborative workspace for states to interact with each other and UI ITSC to share and leverage lessons learned and successful state practices. New Design, Look and Feel

The website now follows the overall branding for NASWA and is fully responsive for any device or browser which provides a better and cohesive experience for our members. In addition, UI ITSC refreshed the website content and streamlined the site navigation for members to easily navigate and find available resources.

Updated UI IT Modernization Status Maps

Under "UI IT Modernization," UI ITSC has provided an overview status of state UI IT modernization projects. With the refreshed website, the maps now display the status of UI Benefits and Tax systems separately.

UI IT Security Resources

The website features an improved UI IT Security section. This section is restricted to state and federal UI employees. Resources include checklists on preparing for security audits, information on UI in the Cloud, and recently published "Security Guidance Supporting UI IT Modernization" that incorporates changes from NIST SP800-53 Revision 5.
