



Save the Date(s): The Ohio Suicide Prevention Foundation (OSPF) announces workforce development in suicide prevention for mental health professionals:

OSPF will be offering four trainings for mental health professionals serving youth (10-24) in the Collaborative Assessment and Management of Suicidality (CAMS). This training will provide counselors, psychologists, and social workers with knowledge, skills, and practice in the treatment of patients' suicidal risk.

3 separate CAMS training components ensure professionals are prepared and confident in their abilities to help patients struggling with suicide ideation:

- 1) A self-paced, 3-4 hour online training teaches CAMS' theory and is required prior to in-person workshop.
- 2) A 1-day role-play workshop provides practice using the CAMS model.
- 3) CAMS consultation calls provide feedback and helpful discussions for professionals implementing the CAMS model with patients.

CAMS is being offered to all Ohio *behavioral health professionals* through funding received by the SAMHSA GLS Grants program. *The only charge for participation is for lunch on the day of the in-person training.*
