I am still working out details and waiting on information/permission, but here is what I know so far regarding City Championship on May 22.

- We will close down Kelly Drive completely overnight beginning at 7 pm on Saturday after Stotesbury. It would re-open at 6 am for regatta traffic on Sunday.
- As most of the larger vehicles boat trailers and food trailers (chuckwagons) will already be
 there, traffic will not be as congested. Entrants at that point will be in this order: staff, coaches,
 referees and spectators. Entrance times will be posted next week.
- Spectators' passes that are dated May 8 can be used again for May 22. Hold on to those passes.
- Chuckwagons parked on the Drive, boat trailers in the St. Joe's lot and most tents may
 remain overnight. If you brought your own tent it can remain. I am still finding out about the
 tents that are rented and will have an answer soon. Security is minimal. You cannot rent your
 own porta-potty. The units from Stotesbury will remain for your use.
- Racing begins at 10 am with time trials for all events including those that were in direct finals
 this past weekend. The lunch break will be at about noon and we will start 45 minutes later for
 afternoon racing.
- Medals will be awarded on land.
- We will livestream all the races even though they are time trials. We will post the link next week.
- Remote parking will be available, and shuttles will run from 8 am to 6 pm.
- City Championship **t-shirts** and other gear will be sold at Stotesbury and at City Championships.




Parking Information:

Team members can get dropped off near Furness Gateway where Kelly Drive and Reservoir drive split.

General parking is near Edgely and the Mount Pleasant Drive Loop marked in pink on the map. There is a rough, hilly (and probably muddy) walking path that leads down to the area where the team tents and spectator areas are located. There is also a shuttle that runs every 20-35 minutes.

NOTE: the blue dot on the map shows the approximate location of the GV Tent. The blue lines show walking paths from parking to the river.





Remote parking lots and shuttle service will begin with the second Flick on March 27. The bus drivers are instructed to stop for drop off/pick-up whenever requested – so be sure your parents know where your parent tent is located for your parents convenience. The lots in Fairmount Park can be reached by following the Kelly Drive detour. Monitored parking will cost \$20 per day. Shuttles are anticipated to run every 20-35 minutes (depending on traffic) from approximately 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. See the map of the remote parking lots above.
