Scripture: Hebrews 10:19-25

¹⁹ Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have **confidence** to **enter** the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰ by a **new** and **living** way opened for us through the **curtain**, that is, his body.

Why enter?

- Faith isn't sustainable in isolation.
- We need encouragement.
- Our 'confidence to enter' isn't based on our faith, but on the faithfulness of Christ.
- You know grace has invaded your soul when you are inclined to say, "we are sinners" instead of "you are a sinner."

²¹ and since we have a great priest over the house of God, ²² **let us** (boldness) draw **near to God** with a sincere heart and with the **full assurance** that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. ²³ **Let us hold** (boldness) unswervingly to the **hope** we profess, for he who **promised** is **faithful**. ²⁴ And **let us** (boldness) **consider** how we may **spur** one another on **toward** love and good deeds, ²⁵ **not giving** up meeting together, as

some are in the habit of doing, but **encouraging** one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Spur means: encourage, point, model, lead, care, walk with, and maybe a swift- kick!
