For over 40 years, Cape Fear Literacy Council (CFLC) has provided **free, personalized tutoring** to adults working toward goals like earning a GED, improving reading and math skills, building essential computer and digital skills, or navigating daily life in English.

In the past year alone, CFLC served **604 students**—our highest ever! Our learners came from **45 countries**, spoke **30 different** languages, and were supported by over **12,000 hours** of tutoring.

WHAT IS ADULT STORY HOUR?

Adult Story Hour is a **six-week series of once-weekly events (Sept 22–Oct 27) held at Azalea Station in Wilmington’s Cargo District**. Modeled after NPR’s *Selected Shorts*, each evening features local authors, artists, and entertainers reading short pieces they love (but didn’t write) to a live audience of 75–100 guests, followed by a brief Q&A.

Previously hosted at Bill’s Brewing Co., last year’s series **sold out** weekly, and we are thrilled our new venue allows us to welcome even more guests this year.
