Section 10 of the current edition of the NAAB's *Procedures for Accreditation*, approved in 2015, describes the purpose of Interim Progress Reports (IPRs) and provides instructions on their preparation.

An IPR is a narrative report supported by evidence that covers three areas:

1. The program's response to, or progress in, addressing not-met Conditions or SPC from the most recent Visiting Team Report.
2. Significant changes to the program or the institution since the last visit.
3. Changes to the program's responses to Conditions I.1-I.5 since the previous Architecture Program Report was submitted. In this section, the program must clearly distinguish new or amended text from that provided in the template. Additional instructions will be included in the template.

All programs that received an eight-year term of accreditation following a visit conducted in 2017 are required to file a two-year IPR by November 30, 2019.

In addition, all programs that received an eight-year term of accreditation following a visit conducted in 2014 are required to file a five-year IPR by November 30, 2019.
