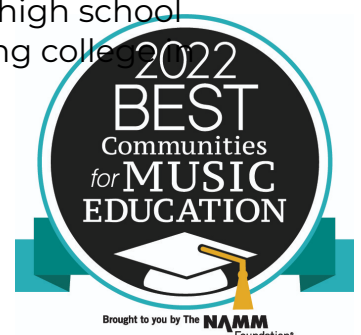
Summer Opportunities for Chagrin Falls Band Students:

Chagrin Falls Band Camp Jr. - June 6th - June 9th (6-8): For students entering 6th-8th grade band. Students will rehearse, play games, and learn new challenging music, concluding with a summer concert and ice cream party! Baldwin Wallace Conservatory of Music - Band Camp - June 26 - July 1, 2023 (5-8): A residential or commuter camp for woodwind, brass and percussion players entering grades 5-10 with a **minimum of nine months playing experience**. Whether you stay overnight or return home in the evenings, students will grow as musicians with rehearsals, sectionals and a final concert, and have fun making new friends through supervised social activities.

Baldwin Wallace Conservatory of Music - Conservatory Summer Institute - July 8th - July 15th (CSI, 9-12): The Conservatory Summer Institute is an 8-day residential high school intensive for students seeking a rigorous musical summer experience. Led by Baldwin Wallace University faculty, students have the opportunity to explore life at BW while growing as a musician through classes, private lessons, ensembles, and coaching sessions.

Oberlin Conservatory of Music Summer Programs (Flute & Trumpet): Summer Programs at the conservatory range from one to two weeks long and are for participants of varying ages from middle school age through adult, depending on the program.

Students work and perform with resident and guest faculty, participate in daily master classes, build skills in individual and group coaching sessions, and gain insight into audition and performance techniques, among other skills.

Lessons, rehearsals, coaching and most concerts take place in the Glauser School of Music. Young Artists are housed in nearby dorms for ease of access to the practice rooms and rehearsal spaces.
