Responsibilities:

The Commons Supervisor/Lunch supervisor will monitor students who flow in and out of the lunchroom to make sure the cafeteria remains a safe, calm and respectful environment. They observe and rectify any inappropriate behavior, including foul language, bullying, arguments, fights, or excessive playing. Supervisors also monitor the room closely to avoid potential health risks, such as allergic reactions, choking and food spills. If seats are assigned, lunchroom supervisors also make sure students sit where they belong. After the meal, supervisors assist with cleaning of the lunchroom, and, in some cases, rearrange or put away the furniture. In addition, supervisors watch the exits to make sure students don't leave the room without permission.

Requirements:

Minimum education qualifications include a High School Diploma or general education degree (GED). Experience in an education setting or with high school aged students preferred. Good inter-personal, communication, and phone skills.
