The next few weeks carry a great deal of significance for the Christian faith and will see a lot of activity in the life for First Christian Church. Holy Week marks the final week in the life of Jesus and his followers prior to his resurrection. Holy week begins with Palm Sunday, the excited observance of Jesus entering Jerusalem. An impromptu parade broke out and branches were cut from trees to wave and place on the ground as a "red carpet" of sorts for Jesus. In the days to follow, Jesus would gather with his disciples for the Passover meal where he gives what we now call the words of institution, the basis for



the meal of communion. In short order Jesus is arrested, tried and on Friday is crucified. This horrific and unjust death marks a perceived ending for those closest to him. Sunday, the day of resurrection, is Easter! Easter carries the discovery that Jesus has been raised from the dead and victorious over any earthly power. We will have experiences of worship and meditation throughout Holy Week to faithfully

observe each of these powerful turning points for Jesus and the faith he imparts. Take note of these opportunities and do your best to faithfully prioritize your participation.




