

Attention parents of students in grades 8-11 for the 2025-2026 school year!

Did you know that your child's SAT-10 test could qualify him/her for membership in the HCS Honor Society?

HCS Honor Society focuses on developing Christians for servant-leadership through learning and service during the high school years. As a member of Honor Society, your child will be given the opportunity to develop as a servant-leader through our chapter's activities:

- Attending monthly meetings that include: talks by industry professionals, service project planning, and discussions and activities on leadership and communication topics
- Participating in various service projects for a minimum of 5 service hours per school year
- Interacting with other like-minded students

As the Xi Iota Chapter of the Eta Sigma Alpha National Home School Honor Society, membership in our club is subject to specific testing requirements, as determined by the national organization.

Membership in the Honor Society is open to any HCS student in grades 9-12 who has a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher and scores in the top 90% on the Stanford Complete Battery (PR/PR-S); however, per the Eta Sigma Alpha National Homeschool Honor Society, scores from at-home tests administered under the supervision of a parent or guardian are not eligible for membership qualification. An adult test supervisor may administer the test in the home, provided the parent is not in the room.

If your student is a potential candidate for the HCS Honor Society and will be taking the SAT-10, you are encouraged to register for the in-person option. Alternatively, if your child took the SAT under parent supervision in the past and you believe she/he may be able to earn a qualifying score, please consider having your child take the CLT Classic Learning Test which is offered multiple times per year, is inexpensive and is administered in the home under strict testing guidelines. <https://www.cltexam.com/>
