

Update from AMHERST SURVIVAL CENTER

The Amherst Survival Center is seeing a real need for food and a lot of challenges by shoppers to get to the Center. So, we are seeking site partners to help facilitate food pantry delivery to area apartment complexes and other readily accessible spaces (school or library parking lot).

Shoppers would register in advance and "order" their groceries, which we package up and deliver to the site (with names on the boxes). Site partners are responsible for initial outreach to get folks to sign up, coordination at the site, unloading the groceries, scheduling pick up times or arranging for socially distant waiting, and then distributing groceries to the residents. Commitment is 3-4 hours monthly for food distribution, plus advance communication with location, outreach to residents, etc.
