He will also develop a creative arts program that will help us advance our mission to make fully-devoted followers of Jesus Christ.



Phillip and Rene Sandifer come to The Lakeway Church from Grace Bible Church in College Station where Phillip has been serving as Pastor of Communications & Worship. After college (Phillip at UT and Rene at Texas State), Phillip and Rene both began their ministry careers with Campus Crusade for Christ. Phillip served with the music ministry originally in Pasadena, CA, and Rene on campus staff at TCU in Ft. Worth.

Phillip traveled for many years in concert and recording ministry writing, recording and producing for himself, many other artists and a variety of recording companies. He also briefly participated in the establishment of a handful of Christian and community radio stations.

This year marks 17 years of Phillip's working in a Pastor/Director position within a large church staff environment. He has developed a passion for teaching the creative process, creating teams and mentoring creative leaders.

Phillip received his Bachelor's degree from the University of Texas at Austin, Master's degrees from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary and Clemson University and a Doctor of Ministry degree from Covenant Theological Seminary.

Prior to spending ten years in Overland Park, KS, and almost two years in College Station, TX, Phillip and Rene lived in Austin for 22 years (in South Austin and Dripping Springs). Together they participated in helping establish Dripping Springs Young Life. And, while working in the Interior Design field, Rene continues to lead and facilitate Bible studies with young women.




