(6+ years):
Indoor/Outdoor Winter
Word Hunt



What you need:

- Printed worksheet (next page)
- Pens, pencils, coloured markers, etc



What to do:

1. Go for a walk around the neighbourhood or in your yard.
2. The children will have to find 3 indoor and 3 outdoor items on their word hunt that begin with each letter that spells out WINTER, for example "I = ice".
3. Give them the opportunity to write down their findings and answers.
4. At the end of the walk take a small break or winter picnic and discuss their findings. This activity encourages language and literacy skills.
5. For the older school agers 9+ years they can write a little poem beginning with each letter or the word WINTER, or even a story on what items they found with that word.
