Wee Beginners (0-18 months): Footprint Wall Hanging Mother's Day Gift

What You Need:

- White model magic clay or you can make salt playdough
- Rolling pin
- Paint and brushes
- Yarn or ribbon
- Sharpie marker



What To Do:

1. Roll the clay or playdough flat for your infant.
If you have an older infant give them the opportunity to roll out the clay or playdough to build their fine motor skills.
2. Wipe the infant's foot clean with a baby wipe or damp cloth.
3. Press the infant's foot onto the clay or playdough until it makes a foot impression.
4. Make one or two holes at the top of the clay/playdough.
5. Allow the project to harden, either for a few hours or overnight.
6. Once it's hardened, let the child paint their creation.
7. On the back of the footprint write "Happy Mother's Day," the child's name and the year it was made.
8. Put a coloured yarn or ribbon through the hole(s) at the top so mom can hang it up.
