

Olympic Ring Prints

Create Olympic Ring prints using paint and a paper towel tube. It's the perfect painting activity for toddlers as it's open-ended and does not require much instruction.



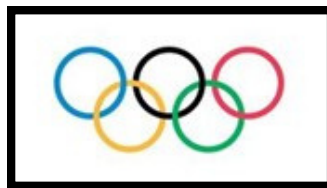
What you need:

- Five paper towel rolls (or toilet paper rolls)
- 5 paper plates
- Tempera Paint/washable paint in Olympic Ring Colours: Blue, green, yellow, red, black
- Large sheet of plain paper

What to do:

1. Pour paint onto plates.
2. Let the creativity fly and start stamping throughout the paper.
3. Practice making patterns using the different colours.
4. Explain the significance of the rings. The colours were the original colours from all the participating countries' flags and the rings symbolise unity.
