Wee Builders(3 - 4 years): Name Hop Letters



Adding a gross motor activity is a fun way for kids to learn the letters of their name!

What you need:

- Small paper plates (or paper)
- Marker
- Tape (painters' tape or masking tape)



What to do:

1. Write each of the letters of the child's name on a paper plate.
2. Attach the tape to the back of the plates to reduce slipping when they are hopping.
3. Scatter the plates around (not in order of their name), keep them a reasonable distance based on the height of the child and the span of their hopping!
4. Call out each letter of the child's name in order and they should hop to that letter. If they know how to spell their names, have them call out each letter and then hop to it!
5. It's fun with more than 1 child – have the letters to their names mixed up and have them hop to their name and then that of their friend or sibling!
