Wee Learners(4 - 5 years):
All About Me!

What You Need:

- Cardstock paper or Bristol board
- Tin foil
- Glue
- Sparkles and glitter
- Markers
- Popsicle sticks



What to do:

1. Draw two oval shapes on cardstock or Bristol board (should be the same size)
2. Cut out the oval shapes
3. Draw and cut out a smaller oval shape in the middle of the cardstock or Bristol board
4. Cut out an oval shape on the tinfoil
5. Glue it in between the two pieces of cardstock/Bristol board (tinfoil looks like a mirror as seen in the picture above)
6. Glue a popsicle stick at the bottom to make it into a handle for the 'mirror'
7. Get your child to colour and decorate the 'mirror'
8. Once they have finished – get them to look in the 'mirror' and ask them "What makes you special?" or "I am special because"

This is a wonderful activity for your child to build on their self-esteem and self-confidence and for you to encourage and empower your children.
