Wee Mentors (6+ years): Tie Dye Beach Towels

What You Need:

- White or cream coloured beach towel or bath towel (preferable cotton towels)
- Painter's or Duct tape
- Spray bottles or squirt bottles
- Fabric Dye (you can purchase it from a craft store)
- Gloves

Disclaimer: This activity should be done outdoors

What You Need:

1. Ask your child to spell out their name on the towel with the tape (or a design of their choice), press the tape down hard to get a clean line.
2. Mix the fabric dye according to the instructions on the bottle. Always wear gloves when mixing the dye colours.
3. Lay the towel outside on solid ground.
4. Get your child to spray or squirt the towel with all the different colours.
5. Once the towel is dry, peel off the tape and rinse the towel in cold water .
6. Let it dry before the child uses it for water play outside.

Note: You will need to wash this towel separately and in hot water. Do not mix it with your other laundry.
