



Wee Play & Learn



Wee Beginners (0-18 months): Velcro Board

This activity promotes independence and teaches children about cause and effect (what side will stick to the board and what side won't). Interacting with textured materials builds their fine motor skills as well!

What you need:

- Velcro strips (you can purchase them from the dollar store or hardware store)
- Wooden board
- Various objects or toys that you can put Velcro on (blocks, Lego's, balls, spoon, etc.)



What to do:

1. Stick one side of the Velcro strips across the wooden board.
2. Cut the opposite side of the Velcro strips so that it can be stuck onto the objects.
3. Place the velcroed wooden board in front of your infant along with the various velcroed objects.
4. Let your infant explore and problem solve.
