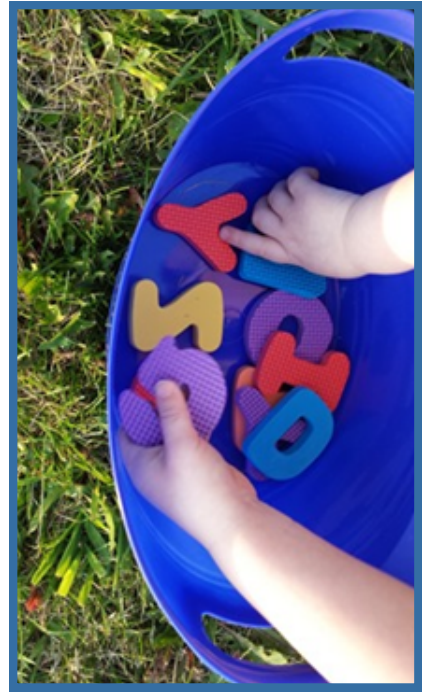


Alphabet Relay Races

This alphabet relay game is a fun way for toddlers and preschoolers to learn letters! It is very easy to set up but is sure to be a blast!

What you need:

- 2 buckets, bowls, container
- Letters - foam, bath, magnetic, puzzle pieces, even pieces of paper with letters written on them will work.



What to do:

1. Set up your buckets (containers) about 20 feet apart
2. Put all of the letters into one of the containers
3. Have your child(ren) stand by the empty bucket
4. Then call out a letter and have the child run and find the letter. Once they find the letter, have them run back to the other bucket and put it in.
5. For older children you can add more difficulty by asking the child to say the sound of that letter or a word that starts with that letter before running back.
