June: Ontario

Providers and children will create their own "Great Lakes" water play area, build their own CN Tower, and they will also be getting ready for the big CANADA 150 celebration happening countrywide on Canada Day.

While in the kitchen children will whip up some Butter tarts, a type of pastry tart that is an integral part of Eastern Canadian Cuisine.

July: Alberta

During the month of July "Together Wee Can Celebrates Canada 150" heads west, taking us to the Prairies where we will learn about the province of Alberta.

While children are exploring Alberta they will learn about the famous Calgary Stampede, make their own horses and personalize their very own cowboy/cowgirl vests. Children will then learn all about the Badlands of Alberta and the Dinosaur Provincial Park, where they will dig for dinosaurs and make dino shoes so they can stomp around like the dinosaurs did in Prehistoric days.

In the kitchen Providers and children will be making maple leaf shaped pancakes in honour of the Calgary Stampede. Did you know every year during the stampede, Calgarians serve and consume more than 200, 000 free pancakes?
