Wee Experts (5 - 6 years): Decorate Your Own Mask

What You Need:

- Plain white reusable face masks
- Fabric markers or fabric paint
- Stickers

Before beginning the project, have a discussion with children about face masks.

Talk to them about why you and other adults they know (i.e. their grandparents or teachers) wear a face mask, how face masks will protect them and the ones they love, and how to properly wear face masks.

What to do:

1. Prewash the face masks before children start decorating them.
2. Give children their own face mask.
3. Ask them to draw, paint, and design a funny or cute face mask they would love to wear and show their friends and family.
4. When they are done, write their name in the corner or the inside of their mask.
5. Have a discussion on what they created. You can take this another step further by getting them to create a face mask for someone else (i.e. a friend, cousin, etc.).
