## What you need:

- Rainbow coloured construction paper
- Markers or crayons
- White construction paper
- Glue
- Scissors



## What to do:

1. Ask your child to draw a cloud on the white piece of construction paper and cut it out.  
Ask your child to write their name on the cloud
2. Precut strips of different colour construction paper ahead of time
3. Give your child one strip of each rainbow colour construction paper and ask them to write something positive about themselves.
4. You can ask your child to describe their personality, what they love, what they are good at, etc.
5. Once they have completed writing about themselves, ask them to glue each strip of construction paper behind the cloud. Take a moment and discuss with your child each word they wrote to describe themselves.
6. Hang up the artwork in their room to remind them of the wonderful person they are
