

TOGETHER WEE CAN "CELEBRATES CANADA 150" 2017

Another fantastic Together Wee Can program is in full swing, "Together Wee Can Celebrates Canada 150".

In honour of Canada celebrating 150 years in 2017, Wee Watch children and Providers are spending the year exploring all parts of Canada; 10 provinces, 3 territories, time zones, landscape, culture, food, celebrations and famous attractions.

We have explored Nunavut, Quebec, Yukon and the Northwest territories so far.

April: Prince Edward Island

Prince Edward Island, also known as PEI is the smallest province in Canada, by land and population.

While children and Providers explore PEI, children will have the opportunity to grow their own potatoes, the islands most famous crop, build a lighthouse, and build a replica of the Confederation Bridge using Lego. Children and Providers will also learn about the red soil on the island, they will make their own red sand and play with it as if they were on a red sand beach in Prince Edward Island.

May: Newfoundland & Labrador

During the month of May "Together Wee Can Celebrates Canada 150" takes us to the most easterly province of Canada, Newfoundland & Labrador. Did you know Newfoundland & Labrador is home to Iceberg Alley? The province is one of the best places in the world to view giant icebergs.

While children are learning about Newfoundland & Labrador, they will complete iceberg experiments, make icebergs, make Puffin masks and pretend they are one of the provincial birds, and make a replica of the famous row of colourful houses known as jellybean row.
