



Wee Play & Learn

Wee Learners
(4-5 years):
Indoor/Outdoor Bowling



What you need:

- 8 empty plastic water bottles
- Paper and markers
- Paint/brush, or various small craft materials
- Plastic ball
- Shovel (if playing outdoors)



What to do:

1. You can paint the bottles in various colours, or you can stuff in various small craft materials inside the bottles
2. Cut paper in 8 circles, and write numbers from 1 to 8 on the circles, then tape each number to each bottle.
3. Line up the bottles as shown in the picture and let the children have fun rolling the ball toward the bottles to see how many they hit.
4. For younger children they can count the number of bottles they hit, and for older children they can add up the numbers that are on each bottle and the total is their score (i.e. if they hit bottles numbered 1, 3 and 6 their score would be 10).

Outdoor instructions: Try bowling in the snow.

1. Shovel a bowling lane into the snow.
2. Line up the bottles as shown in the picture and let the kids have fun rolling the ball toward the bottles to see how many they hit.
