Wee Learners(4 - 5 years): Fizzy Frozen Stars

What You Need:

- Star shaped ice cube tray (you can use a rectangle ice cube tray if you cannot find a star one, or use plastic molds of different shapes)
- Baking Soda
- Food Colouring
- Eyedropper
- Glitter
- Tray
- Vinegar



What to do:

- Mix water and baking soda together. The mixture should not be runny, should be mouldable or packable.
- Add the mixture to the ice cube tray and put it in the freezer overnight.
- Add food colouring to vinegar (you can make two different colours of vinegar).
- You can ask your child to also add glitter to the vinegar.
- Take out the star cubes and place on a tray.
- Ask your child to take the eyedropper and squeeze some vinegar onto the baking soda star cube and see the chemical reaction that will take place. Discuss with your child what occurred, why did it occur, is there anything else they can add to make the same reaction?
