Wee Explorers (18 months - 3 years): Laminated Photo Snow Globe Ornaments

What You Need:

- Snow globe template printed
- Clear contact paper or clear Mac Tac paper (dollar store or craft store)
- White acrylic paint
- Glitter
- Twine
- Cardstock paper (coloured)
- Double sided tape



What to do:

1. Trace the template circles on the clear contact paper or Mac Tac paper
2. Get your child to paint 'snow' on the bottom of the circles and white dots on the top so that it gives an image of winter. Set a side and let it dry completely
3. Cut a picture of your child or children (try not to show any background from the picture)
4. Position the picture where you would like on the circle and secure it with double sided tape. Punch a hole at the top of circle (globe)
5. Trace the base of the globe onto card stock and cut it out. Glue or tape the base near the bottom of the circle
6. You can ask your child to decorate the base with glitter and glue and when they are done write their name and year
7. Tie a twine through the holes and hang it up as a decoration

*if you have a laminator you can use laminating paper for this activity
