

Colour Sorting Mitten Activity

In this activity the children will be working on their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination by using tongs or tweezers. They will also be using their cognitive skills to match and sort the pompoms with the correct colour mitten. Combine it with some simple counting activities and this activity can be appealing to older kids too!

What you need:

- Different colour felt, craft foam or construction paper.
- Corresponding colour pompoms of different sizes
- Plastic tweezers or tongs
- A tray



What to do:

1. Set up the activity on a tray to keep the items together (easy for clean up)
2. Cut mitten shapes out of construction paper or felt. Lay out each mitten in a line.
3. Have the child pick up a coloured pompom using the tweezers (or tongs), then place it on the correct colour mitten.

Activity extension: Talk about the different colours: naming them and then have children find matching colours around them.

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
