

Olympic Torch Handprint Craft

This is a fun and simple project to suit an Olympic theme. Children can use their handprints to make the flames of the Olympic torch! This craft would make an excellent decoration and a cute keepsake.

What you need:

- Scissors
- Washable paint – red, orange and yellow
- Paintbrush
- Coloured construction paper
- White paper



What to do:

1. Draw a torch using the white paper
2. Make the handprint flames – paint on red paint along the palm of the hand, orange in the middle of the hand and yellow paint across the fingers (like a fire[NP1] .)
3. [Optional: you can also trace your hand on red, or orange construction paper and cut it out. Then glue the handprint onto a large piece of construction paper.]
4. Press your painted hand onto the top piece of the coloured construction paper
5. Glue the torch onto the construction paper as if the handprint are the flames of the Olympic torch.
