Wee Beginners (0-18 months): Footprint Mistletoe

What you need:

- Green playdough or clay (you can buy ready made playdough or make your own)
- Sparkles (optional)
- Metallic red pipe cleaners (you can use regular red pipe cleaners)
- Red beads



What to do:

1. Roll out the playdough or clay flat and wide so that you can make imprints of your infant's feet
2. Make sure you press down on each toe of your infant
3. Cut out the footprints.
4. If you have used clay to make the footprints, put it in the oven to bake until it is hard
5. Make two small holes at the heel of the footprint and put the pipe cleaner through the holes, add three beads through the pipe cleaners as well.
6. Tie the two ends of the pipe cleaner together and hang it in your home. When you or any of your family members are under the mistle toe give each other a hug or kiss.

*you can use construction paper or cardboard and paint to make the footprints as well. You can add sparkles to the playdough or clay and mix or kneed
