Wee Mentors (6+ years):
Lemonade Stand for Charity

What You Need:

- Table or crate for the stand
- Construction paper
- Paint
- Paper cups
- Lemons
- Sugar
- Jug
- Box or jar for the money

What To Do:

1. Before starting this project, discuss with your children what charity/organization they would like to raise money for, how much do they want to sell the lemonade for, what are they going to say to the people when they come to buy the lemonade.
2. Paint a lemonade sign on the construction paper and write the name of the charity you are raising money for.
3. Together with your child make the lemonade to sell – squeezing the lemons, adding sugar, adding ice, etc.
4. Pour the lemonade into a jug.
5. Set up a table or the crate outside your front yard. Put the sign up, and if you the time, decorate the table or crate.
6. Have fun selling the lemonade.
7. Discuss with your child how much money together you have raised and go together to drop it off.
