Wee Experts
(5-6 years):
Sock Bunnies



What you need:

Small sock
Felt
Glue
Large Pom pom
Black marker
Ribbon
Elastic bands
Rice



What to do:

1. Fill the sock with about one cup of rice, depending on the size of your sock.
2. Wrap one elastic band to create a head and another at the top of the head to create the ears.
3. Using felt, cut out nose, teeth and a "belly" for the bunny, glue onto the sock.
4. Glue the pom pom onto the back for the tail.
5. Cut the top of the sock in half to create ears, snip the corners to make the ears slightly rounded.

Wee Mentor
(6+ years):
Paper Plate Yarn
Hearts



What to do:

1. Have children fold a paper plate in half and cut a heart out of the middle of the plate for a template.
2. Children can then trace their heart template onto the center of their other paper plate and then cut out the heart shape.
3. Children can use a hole punch and punch holes around the entire perimeter of the heart.
4. Have children pull the needle through one of the holes around the heart and when they reach the end of the yarn tape in place on the back of the paper plate.
5. Children then continue threading yarn around the different holes of the heart until each hole has been used.
6. When you reach the end of the yarn or are finished threading through all the holes of the heart cut the needle off and tape the end of the yarn onto the back of the paper plate.
