Wee Mentors (6+ years):
My Town, My Neighbourhood

What you need:

- Large poster board
- Milk cartons, small cardboard boxes, wood
- Paint and brushes
- Markers, pens, pencil crayons
- Glue and tape



What to do:

1. Ask your child to draw a map of their town or neighbourhood. If they have a difficult time choosing a starting point, they can start with their own home and expand outwards.
2. Include familiar places like the park, convenience store, bank, schools, etc.
3. You can help them draw the roads on the paper to reach these destinations.
4. With the milk cartons, small cardboard boxes, ask your child to make buildings, houses, schools.
5. They can paint the cartons or boxes, and they can draw people on the map or make people with clay or playdough.
6. When it is completed, they can pretend and travel around the map with their cars, dolls, trucks, etc.
