SPRING INSPIRES POETRY WRITING FOR SECOND GRADERS

Spring has sprung in second grade! Taking inspiration from the warm weather, blooming tress, and budding flowers, our second graders crafted spring poems. They used their five senses to describe what spring looks like, feels like, tastes like, smells like, and sounds like. Students incorporated descriptive adjectives in their poems to create a clear picture of how they experience the spring season for their reader.
