Five RKYHS students have come together to field a new student-led Computer Science Team to compete in the American Computer Science League (ACSL) during the 2016-2017 academic year. The ACSL is an international computer science competition including more than 200 schools, where students compete in rounds consisting of both written computer science and programming sections.

The RKYHS Computer Science Team is scheduled to compete in four computer science competitions this year. Each competition consists of a 30-minute written computer science test, along with a take-home coding challenge that requires students to produce code that manipulates strings or integers. Before contests, the team prepares by reviewing relevant topics such as problems converting bases or Boolean algebra.

Computer Science is an exciting and dynamic field that is becoming increasingly important in today's society. The RKYHS Computer Science team is both fun and informative, and new team members are welcomed and encouraged to join. The team is lead by RKYHS Junior, Aaron Dickstein.
