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KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS EXPAND THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF NUMBERS

The students in kindergarten have been learning how to count by 1s, 2s, 5s, and 10s. Each day, we practice these skills using a number line, various manipulatives, and even each other! More recently, the students have been learning the difference between even and odd numbers. We read a story about “Odd Todd” and “Even Steven” and realized that even numbers always have a pair, while odd numbers do not. Many were excited to discover that counting by 2s is really just counting all of the even numbers! This skill will come in handy when adding numbers and recognizing various amounts in a ten frame (which the students have been working on as well). We are very excited to be celebrating the 100th day of school and counting by 1s, 2s, 5s, and 10s all the way up to 100!!! :)
