- Pharaoh enslaves the Jews for fear of them becoming too powerful.
- He tells two midwives, Shifrah and Puah, to kill all of the newborn boys, then tells them to throw them into a river.
- Jocheved gives birth to a son, hides him, then puts him in a basket in a river.
- Pharaoh's daughter takes him to the palace.
- Moshe grows up, he kills an Egyptian that was beating a Jew and flees to Midian.
- He marries Tziporah and is a shepherd.
- The burning bush episode takes place and G-d talks to Moshe.
- G-d tells him that he is going to be the messenger for the people. G-d also appoints Aharon as his spokesman.
- Moshe goes to Pharaoh but Pharaoh refuses to let the Jews go.
- G-d promises He will save the Jews.
- The Haftarah is from The Book of Isaiah, it recalls Hashem's acts to Mitzrayim, and foretells the Messianic Redemption, where we will unite in Yerushalayim.
