SEVENTH GRADERS EXPLORE TEL AVIV AND LEARN NEW HEBREW VOCABULARY

The seventh graders have been exploring the city of Tel Aviv through art, articles and song. We have learned about the Hiriya Mountain and Ariel Sharon Park in Tel Aviv which is built on and around a man-made structure due to originally being a landfill. We also learned how it has now become the grounds of environmental activists to promote recycling and a “Green” world. We discussed why it’s important to recycle and keep our environment clean. The students were then encouraged to use their existing vocabulary and the new words of this week to create their very own advertisement with a partner to have people join the “Green” movement. Each pairing took turns presenting their advertisement to the class. The students were very creative and convincing in their presentations.

Inspired by the recent elections, the students then learned new vocabulary words related to voting. The class used the new vocabulary words and voted for their favorite advertisement. Each class created a newspaper combining all of the advertisements they had created, which is now posted in the classroom.

The new words we covered during these lessons are:

מידע - Meyda - Information

ממחזר - Memachzer - recycling

נקי - Naki - Clean

זבל - Zevel - Garbage

בחירות - Bechirot- Elections

לבחור - Livchor - To choose

להצביע - Lehatzbiyah - To vote
