The weekly Torah readings during this month of Cheshvan introduce us to Avraham and Sarah, who modeled kindness for the Jewish people for all times. This month, students will be presented with many opportunities to engage in acts of kindness. At JKHA, our students learn hands-on about Chesed and to set attainable goals at an age-appropriate level.

JKHA Early Childhood are the leaders for this month's theme/ They have decided to send all tzedakah collected to the Jewish Relief Agency (JRA). JRA is a volunteer-led organization that delivers groceries to households in need nationwide. The local Metrowest chapter serves several hundred families in our area. All packing and delivering is done by volunteers, and all food is delivered directly to recipients' doorsteps.
