Melacha Of The Week:

מְפָשֵׁט - Skinning

- This includes removing the skin of a newly slaughtered animal, and spreading it out
 - This only applies to non-cooked animals, so one MAY remove skin from chicken on Shabbat, provided that they do it with their hands, immediately before eating the chicken, and that they take some of the actual chicken off as they remove the skin
