Halacha of the Week

One should say the 15 Brachot at the beginning of davening (Birchot haShachar) in order, according to the text of the siddur.

If one said Matir Asurim before Zokef Kefufim, they continue the brachot in order. Else, one may say the brachot out of order.

They may be said standing or sitting.

Even though one answers "amen" to the chazan's brachot, it is better to say them individually.
