You will also get the opportunity to tour our theatres including the newly renovated Balcony Theatre in the sensory setting.

The Strand Sensory Series is an effort to help our neighbors in their quest for seeking local entertainment where they will not have to feel “different” about being the unique individuals they are. The sensory friendly initiative allows individuals with autism, developmental disabilities, and other sensory needs, the ability to see and experience all the things the world has to offer.

Beginning in March, the Strand will launch their Sensory Friendly initiative with their monthly Sensory Series. Every 3rd Saturday of the month at 10am, we will show a film in the preferred setting—lights on with lower volume in one of our downstairs theatres. The first film will be on Saturday, March 17th with exhibition of *A Wrinkle in Time*. Admission is just \$5 per person; doors will open at 9:30am.
