If you are not currently receiving services at our agency, please also send a copy of your child's most recent speech evaluation or IEP/IFSP.

An enrollment packet for the specific program(s) of interest will be provided starting **March 19**. Preferences are considered but not guaranteed. Registration is "first come first served". The enrollment packet must be returned by **Monday, April 16**. The program descriptions are a general guideline and may be adjusted based on enrollment. Programs will be held within the City of Delaware.

## Language & Literacy Programs for Young Children

### Sing, Laugh, Play!

7 weeks; Mondays 9am-10am or 1030-1130am, June 4 through July 16  
Toddlers participate in fun language stimulating activities incorporating play, movement and music. A caregiver must attend with the child. Intended for ages 18-36 months and led by a Speech Therapist. Fee=\$200

### Preschool Language Program

9 weeks; week of June 4 through week of July 30 (off July 4<sup>th</sup>)  
Mon/Wed 9:30-11:30am or Tues/Thurs 9:30-11:30am or Tues/Thurs 1230-230pm  
This program is designed for preschool -aged children with moderate to severe language delays. Children participate in a preschool routine with art, music, movement and play used to target communication and interaction skills. Two Speech Therapists will lead the program. Minimum age of three. Fee=\$685

### Early Childhood Literacy Program

9 weeks; Monday/Weds 12:30-2:30pm, week of June 4 through week of July 30  
Children age four through rising first graders participate in hands-on learning activities to improve phonological skills and build relationships with peers. This group is intended for children who are "at-risk" for difficulties with literacy development due to mild to moderate speech and language delays. Two Speech Therapists will lead the program. Minimum age of four. Fee=\$685

### Approaching Apraxia

5 weeks; Mondays 1-2pm (1) June 4 thruh July 2 or July 9 thru August 6  
Weekly small group of children with diagnosed or suspected apraxia. Will provide repetitive practice of consonant and vowel combinations phrases while also addressing sound awareness. Facilitated by at least one Speech Therapist. Fee=\$225

## Language & Literacy Programs for School-Aged Children

### Social Groups

7 weeks; Wednesdays 9-10am (Ages 5-8), 1030-1130am (Ages 9-12) June 8 through July 27  
These small groups provide the opportunity for children to target specific social language skills and build relationships with peers. Facilitated by at least one Speech Therapist. Fee=\$225

### Read, Create, Write!

6 weeks; Fridays 9:15am-10:15am or 1030-1130am, June 22 thru July 27  
This group session will provide a creative end to the week by focusing on developing expressive and receptive language skills through reading stories, creating art and writing narratives. It will be led by a Speech Therapist who is also a Registered Art Therapist. This program is designed for children entering grades 1-4 with mild to moderate language delays. Fee=\$200



### Cooking for Picky Eaters

6 weeks; Thursdays 9am-10am, June 22 through August 1  
There will be simple cooking and eating opportunities, but we will also have fun with food. We will play and experience food with our senses and make things out of food materials. This group is designed for children age 5 through 8 who have difficulty participating in and enjoying meal times. The group is led by an Occupational Therapist and a Speech Therapist. Fee=\$275

### Cooking for Life Skills

6 weeks; Thursdays 1030am-1130am, June 20 through August 1  
Participants will learn and practice kitchen skills while sharing cooking experiences with peers. Motor skills, sequencing, problem solving will be integrated with group interaction and communication. This is designed for children ages 9-14. The group is led by an Occupational Therapist and a Speech Therapist. Fee=\$275



### Daily Living with Communication Devices

6 weeks; Fridays 9-10am (ages 6-8) 1030-1130am (ages 9-11), June 11 through July 23  
Small groups of children with alternative communication devices will focus on increasing independent use of routine phrases through repetition, increasing expressive vocabulary and formulating phrases. The small group is facilitated by at least one Speech Therapist. Fee=\$200
