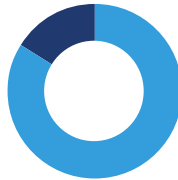


THANK YOU DELAWARE COUNTY for passing DCBDD's new 0.4 mil continuous levy! This will provide a long term stable funding source for many years to come.
