



Safety Town

City of Delaware Safety Town is an educational program for children entering kindergarten or first grade in fall of 2020. This interactive program is designed to educate children in safety topics and techniques that can be utilized in real-life situations. Topics include: fire safety, bike, bus, pedestrian safety, the proper use of 911, poisons, stranger awareness, traffic safety, and animal safety. In addition participants will be introduced to firefighters, police officers, school bus drivers, and many other community helpers.

Please take a couple of minutes to review the following information:

- Due to high demand, students may only attend Safety Town one time.
- Safety Town is held at Willis Intermediate School located at 74 W. William St. Temporary parking for drop off and pick up is permitted in front of the school.
- Parents are not required to stay for Safety Town. Parents should feel free to stop in at any time to observe but must sign in with staff.
- Children should be dressed appropriately for the weather conditions. Many activities take place outside, provide jackets and rain coats when necessary. **Closed toe shoes are mandatory.**
- Please bring your child inside each day and make sure that you sign your child in and out at the attendance table. **Picture ID is required for pick up.** If anyone not listed on your registration form is picking up, please add them to the authorized list at the attendance table.
- If an emergency arises and you must get in touch with your child or the Safety Town staff, contact the Delaware Police Department at 740-203-1111. Explain the situation to the dispatcher. They will take the information and contact Officer Robert Hatcher.
- Fire Station Tour Day (Thursday) – We will meet at Willis and take the bus to the fire department. The children will spend the day taking a tour of the fire station, located at the corner of S. Liberty St. and Park Ave. We will meet back at Willis at the regular time.
- Graduation (Friday) - Please plan on coming joining us for the graduation at 10:35am (morning session) or 2:20pm (afternoon session), as the children will prepare a special program and review of what they have learned before receiving their certificates and special graduation gifts.
