AWARD GUIDELINES:

- Nominee must be an active member of the VYPG by participating in multiple activities, events and meetings throughout the year.
- Nominee must demonstrate a success in their chosen profession.
- Nominee must show a desire to improve their community through being active in local non-profits, charities or civic service.

Nomination Process:

- Nominators must submit an application including a short paragraph on why the person being nominated deserves the award.
- All nominations must be submitted no later than September 1st to the VYPG President, Douglas Gillikin·

- All Nominations will be reviewed by members of the VYPG executive committee.
- Once a decision has been made the finalists will be presented to the Chamber and appear in the October newsletter. The winner will be announced at the annual Chamber Awards Luncheon to be held in October.
