A similar House version [H 1481](#) by **Rep Goff-Marcil** which requires vacation rental license applicants to provide Division of Hotels & Restaurants (of DBPR) with certain information is before the [Regulatory Reform Subcommittee](#).

The Chamber opposes any bill that shifts the regulatory authority for Vacation Rental Units from local government to state government. Cities and Counties should regulate these Rental Units for fire, noise, zoning, ADA and make sure proper sales and bed taxes are collected.
