However, city officials throughout the State lobbied energetically against the proposed measure claiming it assails “home rule” authority.

Rep Raburn noted several CRA ‘excesses’ over the years including disproportionate administrative costs and unwarranted extension dates to reduce slums or produce affordable housing.

H 13 was added to the House Special Order Calendar for Tuesday, April 25.

Senate companion [S 1770](#) by Sen Lee includes the accountability measures, but also requires a super-majority vote of council or board members to create new CRAs or extend the life of an existing one beyond 2037 to eliminating all CRAs. However, the Appropriations Subcommittee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development voted down **S 1770** its chances of it proceeding there appear dim.
