Thank you for your interest in the Flagler Volusia Public Leadership Institute (FVPLI), a free candidate education program of the Daytona Regional and Flagler County Chambers.

Our region has made great progress creating a healthier business climate and supporting economic development. We are fortunate to have elected officials who understand what it takes to keep moving in the right direction; however, to ensure we keep following the right path, our community needs to identify, cultivate and encourage the <u>next</u> generation of public leaders. By providing prospective candidates with information to decide whether and when they should run for office, FVPLI helps build that bench of people willing to serve in future leadership roles.

The Daytona Regional and Flagler County Chambers are collaborating this year to reach applicants. Drawing on the expertise of current elected officials and business/community leaders, participants gain insight to help them navigate the road to public office. A limited number of applicants (20 to 25) are selected to participate in this program, based on a competitive application and interview process led by a selection committee. Those invited to participate in FVPLI will be notified in early August and will receive a full scholarship thanks to the support of program sponsors.

The class will meet Friday, September 8 and Friday, September 15 from 8AM - 4PM at the Flagler County Chamber of Commerce located at 20 Airport Road in Palm Coast, and the same time on Saturday, September 9 and Saturday, September 16 at Daytona Regional Chamber, 126 E Orange Ave, Daytona Beach. There will be a kickoff reception for participants, sponsors, staff, facilitators and guests Thursday, September 7 from 5:30 - 7PM at the Flagler Chamber.
