

Workforce Housing continued.....

The House proposed an \$87.2 billion budget which allocates \$123 million to affordable (workforce) housing programs and reroutes \$182 million for K-12 Education and other purposes.

The Senate proposed an \$87.3 billion budget which allocates \$322 million to affordable (workforce) housing programs.

The Sawdowski Fund collects a surcharge from real estate transactions to be applied to affordable housing purposes. Each year, the fund generates an estimated \$320 in revenue.

**S 874 by Sen Passidomo / H 191 by Rep Shaw** would prohibit the legislature in the future from allocating Sadowski Trust funds to other purposes.
